- The dramatic improvement of facilities such as the Paediatric Day Unit and Haematology Day Unit, making hospital appointments quicker and more comfortable for patients.

**SPEEDING UP DIAGNOSIS
OF CRITICALLY ILL PATIENTS**

£84,500

A new diagnostic test has been developed diagnosing infections accurately in a matter of hours and allowing the right treatment to be given immediately – saving time and lives.



**MAKING HOSPITAL
MORE WELCOMING**

£250,000

The refurbished, more child-friendly Paediatric Day Unit makes better use of available space with vibrant artwork and interactive play systems distracting and occupying children waiting in clinics.



**APP INJECTS FUN INTO
VITAL PHYSIOTHERAPY**

£40,000

A physiotherapy monitor linked to games on a smartphone app, turns tedious physiotherapy for children with cystic fibrosis into fun, reducing family stress.



**EL SALVADOR-CAMBRIDGE
HEALTH PARTNERSHIP**

£115,000

Cambridge Global Health Partnerships worked with partners in El Salvador to improve the health of vulnerable babies, and mothers who are 5x more likely to die giving birth than in the UK.



**SAFER SCANNING FOR
TINY BABIES**

£340,000

The Sir Jules Thorn Charitable Trust and a legacy funded an MRI incubator to enable the sickest, smallest babies into the heart of the scanner without impacting on their care.



**IMPROVING PROSTATE
CANCER DIAGNOSIS**

£29,700

CAMPROBE (Cambridge Prostate Biopsy Device) has been developed to improve safety and accuracy in prostate cancer diagnosis, allowing biopsies to be performed under local anaesthesia.



**LIFE-SAVING TRANSPLANT
TECHNOLOGY**

£250,000

You have enabled surgeons to test livers before transplanting them, using those that would previously not have been viable. This means 50 more lives will be saved over 2 years.



**QUICKER CARE FOR YOUNG
CANCER PATIENTS**

£63,000

Helped in funding a Cancer Care Co-ordinator ensuring that appointments run on time, with test results and treatments ready promptly, so children with cancer get faster treatment.



**RE-OPENING OF THE
HYDROTHERAPY POOL**

£57,300

You supported the re-opening of the hydrotherapy pool, used by children and adults with chronic pain and those rehabilitating after injury or operations who are unable to exercise on dry land.



**SUPPORTING CLINICAL
RESEARCH**

£110,000

Such as Dr Ben Warne's work on antibacterial resistance; including the study of a bacteria considered a 'critical' priority, posing the greatest risk to health.



**INTENSIVE CARE MENTAL
HEALTH SUPPORT**

£58,381

You helped fund a team looking after patients recovering in intensive care who are at risk of mental health problems; addressing psychological issues and providing support for families.



**REVAMPED HAEMATOLOGY
DAY UNIT**

£308,000

The Haematology Day Unit has been refurbished, more than doubling capacity, allowing for a wider range of treatments to be delivered and reducing waiting times.
