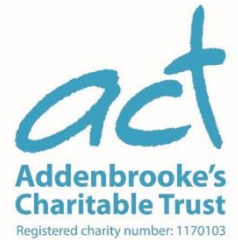


ACT Fundraising Volunteer



Are you a friendly person who likes talking to people? Are you passionate about the excellent work that the Addenbrooke's and Rosie's hospitals do?

Our fundraising volunteers are the friendly face of Addenbrooke's Charitable Trust (ACT) in their local communities. They help to build new relationships within their local areas, encourage fundraising activities, and raise awareness of how people can help us continue to make Addenbrooke's even better.

Responsibilities include:

- If you enjoy speaking to small groups and inspiring local organisations or are interested in trying this for the first time, you can help our hospitals by giving talks (both 'virtually' online or in person) on behalf of ACT.
- Helping raise the visibility of our charity, promoting ACT's fundraising initiatives, and helping to distribute fundraising literature around your local community.
- Encouraging local shops, community groups, and venues to display collection tins and then collect the funds once the tins are full!
- Promoting our 'Member get member' initiative – volunteer with a friend!
- Supporting us as we establish new fundraising groups across our region. This new network of local groups will organise events to raise money to help our hospitals. From bake sales and balls to bucket collections and barn dances, they can plan and promote all sorts of fun events in their local communities to make Addenbrooke's even better
- There's also the opportunity for fundraising volunteers to introduce us to local businesses and organisations or share with the team any fundraising opportunities within your area.
- When appropriate, attending events organised by our fundraisers as the 'face' of the charity, tasks may include -
 - Marshalling
 - Helping to set up and clear down the event
 - Welcoming participants to the event
 - Cheering on participants
 - Handing out refreshments

All of this comes with the support from the Fundraising Team at ACT, who will help to support and guide you.

What we will do for you

You will be joining a growing, friendly volunteer team and the time you give will make a real difference in people's lives.

Training for the role will be provided as well as ongoing support.

We will cover travel expenses and provide a reference after two months in the team.
